PE days for both classes are Wednesday and Thursday .

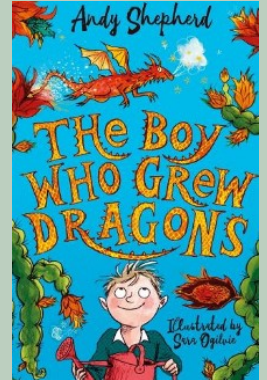
Mulberry also have Forest School on a Friday afternoon.

We'll find out what it's like to have pet dragon but we need to keep it a secret because who wouldn't want their own dragon?

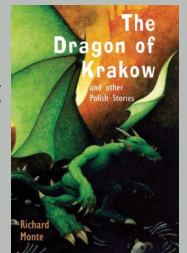


Home Reading

Maths

This half term we will be continuing with mental strategies for addition and subtraction before we move onto learning the column method. Towards the end of the half term, we will looking at multiplication and division. 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Art

In Art this half term we are looking at the work of Ellen Jewett, Sharlena Wood and Sarah Taylor as we explore a range of different colours and materials to create our own mixed media piece. We will be looking at manmade and natural materials.

History

In our humanities lessons, we will be focusing on the Iron Age where we will look at how it fits into the history that we have studied at the infant school and understand why this era ended.



Science

Opposites attract!! This half term we are going to be working scientifically and investigating the strengths of different magnets. We will be classifying different materials and investigating magnetic forces at a range of distances.

RE
