I hope that you all had a wonderful Easter Holiday break, despite all the rain! It has been lovely to see all the children this week in their final term of the academic year. Over the holiday period our site team worked hard to upgrade some of our learning areas, with a new entrance to the Foundation Stage area, new storage and toilets in preschool, new fencing to our Infant school pastoral rooms and new toilets in the KS1 corridor. On the Junior site, there is a new door to our reading garden, and we have also started making some changes to the reception area - you may have already noticed a repainted front door! Continuing the theme of improving toilet facilities, the outdoor toilets have been refurbished and reopened for easy access from the playground.

Our thanks to the PTFA for organising these fun events for our school community.

Over this term there will be lots going on as we continue with year group Book Cafes, and we will also be inviting Parent/Carers to come into school on the 8<sup>th</sup> May or 19<sup>th</sup> June to see 'A Day in the Life of a Primary Pupil'. This will be a great opportunity for you to see the school on a typical day, with children enjoying their learning and benefitting from some of our amazing facilities.
