We can't wait to see what amazing creations the children will make.



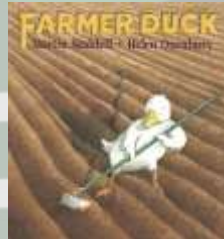
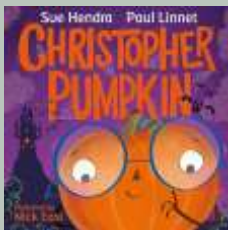
### Science and Humanities
