Welcome back!

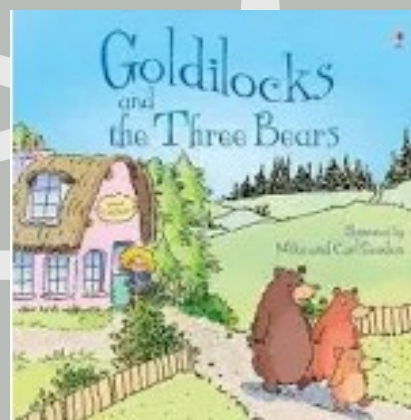
We hope you all had a lovely half term and are ready for Spring 2. We have so much to look forward to this half term. Our theme for Spring 2 is 'Enchanted Forest.'



English

To inspire our writing, we will be going on a walk through the woods at the Junior school! We will also be reading lots of traditional tales like 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' as well as traditional tales with a twist.

In our writing this half term, we will be using these key story texts to write a letter of apology from The Big Bad Wolf to the Three Little Pigs using the prefix 'un.' We will then be learning a 'Talk 4 Write' story map all about 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' to help us with our story writing! Our final piece of writing will be looking at writing our own version of Goldilocks and the Three Bears.



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Our learning this half term!

Science - We will be learning to predict, observe and record weather. We will also interpret our findings.



Geography - We will be learning about directional and locational language so we can follow directions on a map and also begin to understand the difference between physical and human geography.



Art - We will be learning about cool and warm colours, how colours link to emotions and we will create our own enchanted forest using silhouettes, different textures and warm and cool colours.



PE - The children will be looking at Health Related Education (HRE) and Football. In HRE, the children will learn to use their body effectively during different exercises. In football, we will learn how to pass and shoot so we will be able to apply our skills to a match!



RE - In RE we will be learning about Muslim beliefs. We will be exploring the creation story from a Muslim perspective.



RHE/PSHE - We will be learning all about keeping ourselves safe and healthy. We will be learning about healthy choices, how to get help when poorly and how being healthy helps makes us feel happy.



Maths

This half term we will be learning about:

- Place value of numbers between 20-50
- Partitioning numbers between 20 and 50
- Length and height using objects and rulers
- Mass and volume using scales and measuring jugs

Reading

Keep reading at least 3 times a week and record it in your child's yellow reading record. Reading is incredibly important and it really does make a huge difference when a child reads daily. So let's get reading Year 1.
