Blossom have a few more weeks of swimming left however when Blossom finish swimming, they will need their PE kit on a Monday and Wednesday.

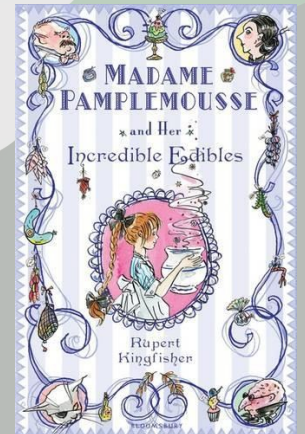
Mulberry's PE days are Monday and Wednesday however this will change to a Monday with swimming on a Thursday once they start their swimming lessons.
