Dear Parent/Carer,

This week at the Junior School, we were visited by Ofsted. The Junior school children have all made me very proud. They have been resilient in the face of last-minute changes and both polite and welcoming as they saw me and the inspectors moving around school. Many thanks to those parents who completed the online survey we sent to you along with the Ofsted visit letter, your feedback as always is invaluable to us to ensure we are meeting the needs of all our families. There is now a 30-working day wait for the published report, but I will write to you again before that with some information about the new framework and report format- we were the first school to be inspected in Hamwic and BCP under the new framework!

School Trips

Here at the Federation we understand that everybody learns in different ways. Whilst we cannot always take the learning outside of the classroom, we do endeavour to make the learning environment as varied and interesting as possible. One such way we try to achieve this is through the various school trips and visitors we invite into school to support the children's learning and bring it to life. We always consider the cost of these carefully and also work with people from our local area such as BCP Teams, Bournemouth University and St Clements Church to help keep costs down. We appreciate that families may be under financial pressure, however timely payment for school trips/visits is necessary to ensure we can continue to still offer our students these opportunities now and in the future.
