Dear Parent/Carer,

As we notified you earlier in the week, our Infants school were visited by the Ofsted team this week. It made me very proud to hear so many lovely compliments about the children from the inspectors as they moved around school. As soon as we have received the official report we will communicate the results to you.

Nut Free School Reminder

Please can I remind all parents/carers that both of our school sites have a no nut policy for both children and adults. We have number of children and staff who have severe nut allergies and bringing these products on site puts them at risk of cross contamination.

Our Health and Safety Policy states:

17. Nuts/Nut Products including Sesame Seeds

The Federation has a strict 'no nuts' policy within both schools. We request that no nuts or nut products are bought into the school. We ask parent/carers to be aware of this policy when providing their children with their packed lunches and additional snacks during the day.

The school holds details of all children or staff known to have a nut allergy and we regularly request parent/carers to keep the school updated with health plans to ensure we have the most up to date information regarding their medical condition at all times.

Toys In School

We have had some incidents of children trying to trade/swap toys or sell them to one another. To ensure there is no upset caused, we kindly request parents to ensure your child/ren do not bring toys or collection cards eg Pokemon into school.

Local Residents Around School

We have had several complaints from residents stating they have been verbally abused by members of our community. May I remind all of our parents/carers to be kind, courteous and considerate of our local residents when arriving, leaving or moving around the streets surrounding the Federation.

May we also remind everyone to park safely, legally and respectfully. Please ensure you do not park on corners so as to decrease the visibility for safe crossing, block residents' driveways, park on double yellow lines or in the designated Coach or disabled bays (unless you have a blue badge). We do have regular visits from the parking wardens to try and combat this ongoing problem at the request of local residents, after a rising number of incidents being reported to both ourselves and BCP council.

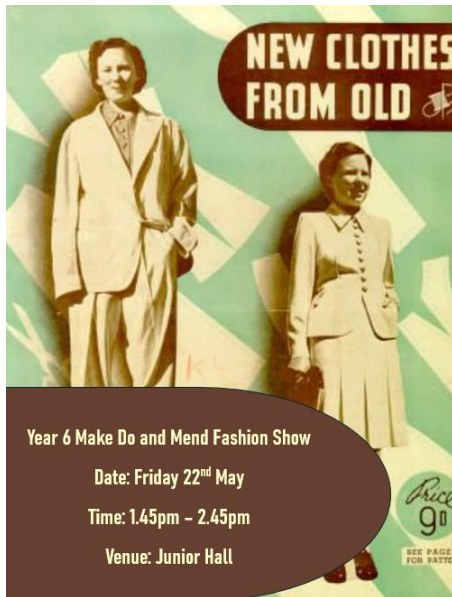
