Transition morning

Nut Free School

We have seen a few incidents recently where children have had nut-based items for snack or in their lunchbox. We have several children as well as members of our staffing team across different sites and Year groups who have severe nut allergies. To be able to safeguard everyone we kindly ask that children do not come to school with any items in their lunchbox eg Nutella sandwiches that contain nuts.

Thank you for supporting us to ensure we keep everyone in our Federation safe.

Hot School Dinners

It is lovely to see so many of our children from pre-school to Year 6 enjoying a hot school meal every day. On occasion, children will not eat what is provided for them so we ask that when you place your orders you choose only the meals that you know your child will eat from the menu. Sadly, we do not have spare meals and we are unable to provide an alternative if your chosen option is refused.

Reviewing the menu together can be a great opportunity to spend time with your child, discuss the choices available, and help them select meals they will enjoy. We would hate for any child to spend the afternoon hungry because they have not eaten their lunch.

Headlice

It has come to our attention through several reports from various Year groups across our Federation that there is a persistent and ongoing problem with headlice. We would be very grateful if you would please assist us in trying to overcome the problem by inspecting your child's hair at least once a week. If your child has head lice, products can be purchased at a chemist or supermarket for treatment.
